 Rear valve covers, oil pans, timing covers, water pumps, thermostat housing, transmission pans etc.

# APPLICATION DIRECTION

- 1. Surfaces must be clean, dry and free of dirt, grease, oil or water.
- 2. Puncture the tube with cap and install nozzle. Apply 2 4 mm bead to one surface only.
- 3. Fix the parts to be assembled before sealant skins over. Skin over time is 5 minutes.
- 4. Uncured sealant can be cleaned up with mineral spirits.
- 5. Replace cap after use and store in a cool, dry place.

Product releases methylethylketoxime during application and curing. Contains aminosilane. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Causes serious eye irritation. Avoid breathing vapours.
