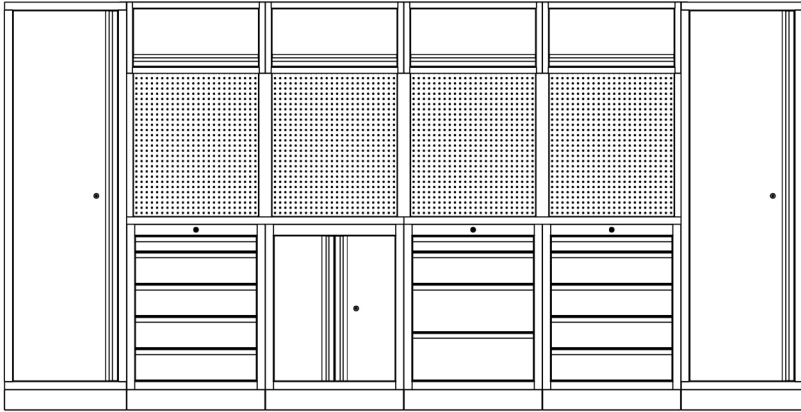

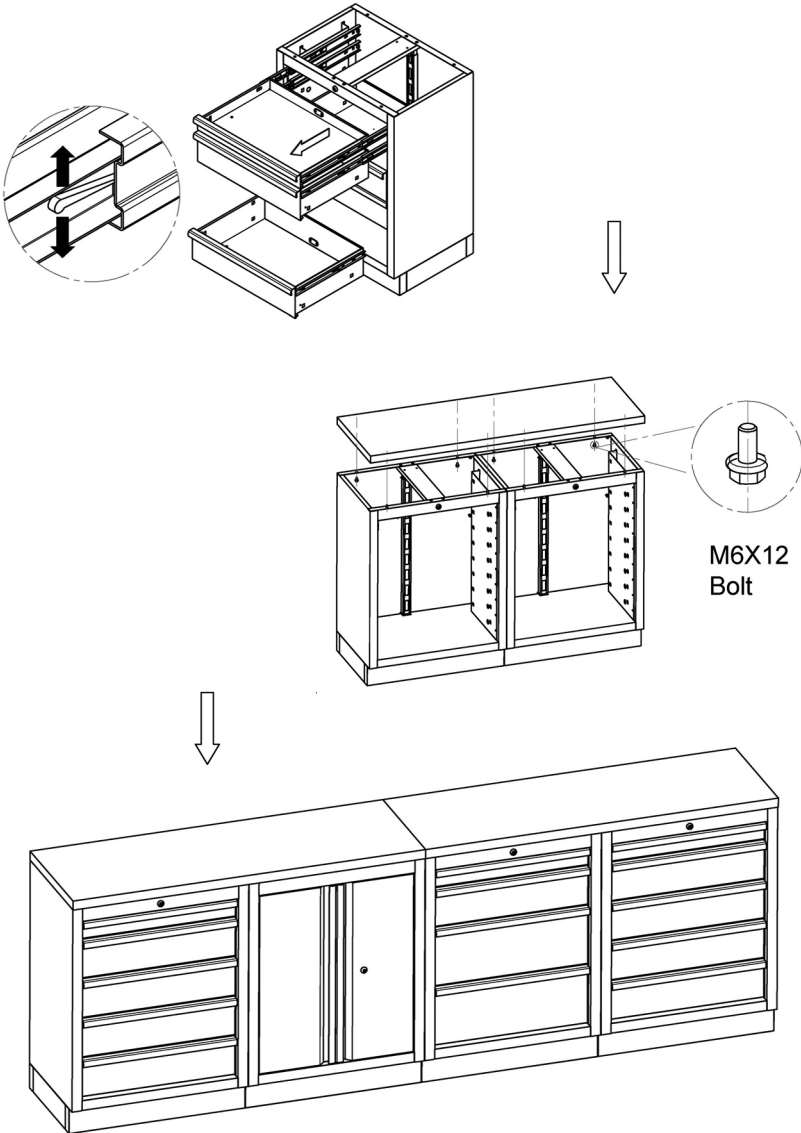
1. Ensure Health & Safety, local authority, and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using this storage system.

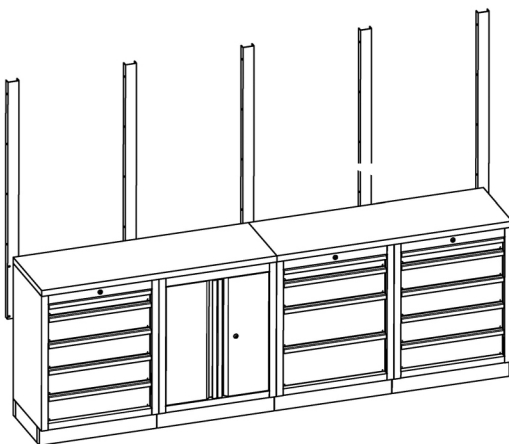
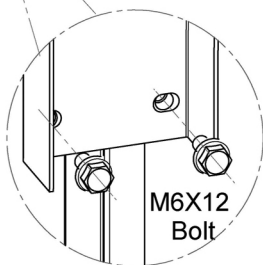
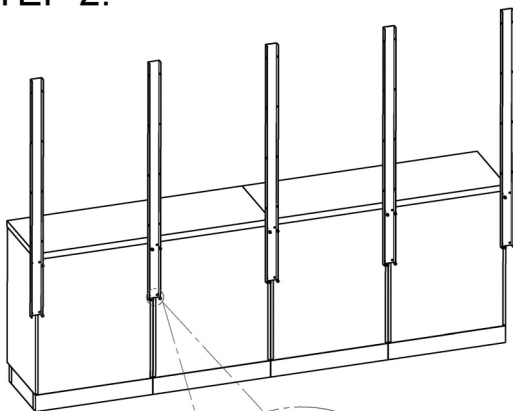
1. Place all parts in a clear area and arrange them on the ground in front of you. Check for completeness and for any transport damage
